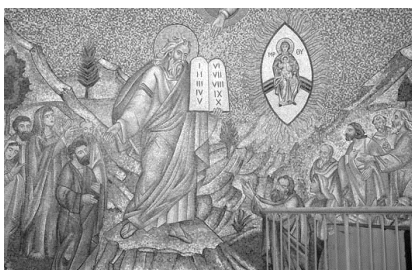
GET INVOLVED TODAY – JOIN A COMMITTEE
